The Dolwyddelan Cycle Map introduces cross country cycle routes on broad forestry trails that can be used to explore the local area, reach neighbouring villages or provide a full day of off road cycling in an area of outstanding natural beauty.

From here we have access to routes that connect three breath taking valleys containing the rivers Lledr, Llugwy and Machno. The area can also boast being centrally positioned in relation to three top class mountain biking facilities; the long established Marin Trail, the challenging Penmachno Trails and the extreme Antur Stiniog downhill trails in Blaenau Ffestiniog.

Pick up a copy of the leaflet from the Pavilion, the Bike Trail notice board in the train station car park, or Elen's Castle Hotel.
